


CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Our construction is continuing on! We're still waiting on glass to arrive but our crew has been busy working on the interior! We have flooring down & ceiling tiles up. We'll have beautiful new entryways before long. We can't wait!

We would like to say thank you to all of our patrons for their continued support despite the challenges (and noise) brought about by construction. Our ultimate goal is to make our 100+ year old building watertight so we can continue to serve our patrons for many more years to come.

Remember, we're still open! You can park at the back of the building and come on in.

EXCITING NEWS!

We are thankful to be a recipient of a grant provided by the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Louisiana Foundation.



This grant has provided us the opportunity to set up a private space for patrons to use for online telehealth medical visits or other important phone conversations/online meetings.

Many of our Franklin Parish residents must periodically seek specialized medical care outside of the parish in places like Monroe, Baton Rouge, New Orleans and Shreveport, among other areas. Some of these visits could be accomplished using telehealth services rather than a lengthy, sometimes costly, trip. It's convenient and, oftentimes, more comfortable to seek medical care via telehealth services when possible.

With this grant, we were able to purchase a private workspace booth where patrons can utilize our public Wi-Fi services and have these important conversations with their medical team privately and free of distractions without leaving Franklin Parish.

Patrons may bring their own devices or request to use one of our public laptops within this space.

We just heard from the manufacturer that our booth has been constructed. It should be delivered \mathcal{E} set up within the next 4 weeks.

We're excited to be able to provide this private working space to our patrons.
