

21st May, 1989, Saturday

The woods are full of locusts, they keep a continuous singing noise and have been for the past three weeks or more. This morning I hear a louder and coarser noise, but of the same character, they seem to be more numerous than I have ever heard before.

Some kind of a little black, hard-shelled bug has been more destructive of corn this spring than I ever heard of, except the spring of 1882, then they were confined to sections of the country that had been overflowed, for we had very high water years, but this year they are in sections that water never bothers.
