

Did you ever wonder, “what’s that blue building beside the library?” We’ve discovered that many of our parish residents didn’t know that we had a conference building right next door! In 2007, the Franklin Parish Library remodeled the building and dedicated it as the Franklin Parish Library Learning Center. Previously the 2nd Jitney Jungle (1930’s), our Learning Center has a large and a small conference room available for use. Non-profit organizations can rent the Learning Center at no cost for conferences or events. We also use it for our own events such as summer reading or guest speakers. Soon, we’ll have some of our very own Franklin Parish High School student’s art being displayed throughout the year!
